Since the organization of the Florida State Elks Association in 1904, Ocala Lodge 286 and the lodges of North Central District have been proud to sponsor six of the Association's State Presidents. At the second state convention held in Ocala in 1905, Herbert A Ford was the first Ocala Lodge member elected to serve as the State President. Fast forward 53 years – Willis V. McCall, Sheriff of Lake County and a PER from Eustis Lodge 1578, was elected to serve the 1958-1959 term. At the 1981 State Convention, Ocala Lodge 286 not only won the State Ritual contest, but it was also the home lodge of the newly elected state president, Richard Shashy. Ten years later, Ocala won the State Ritual contest again and Ben S. Brown, Jr. of Eustis Lodge was elected as SP. Ben Brown is well-remembered for his service as the Florida Elks Children's Hospital Administrator and its successor program, Florida Elks Children's Therapy Services. In 1996, Winston Needham became the third Ocala Lodge 286 member to serve as the State President. The most recent North Central District member to serve as State President was Charles Trinowski from Winter Park Lodge 1830 during the 2006-2007 term.



The current Vice President at Large (VPAL) for the State is Russel J. Smith PDDGER from South Lake Lodge 1848. He is expected to be elected as our next State President in 2024. Each VPAL and State President has a busy travel schedule attending State, Area 3, and National events. While a portion of the costs to travel is covered by the State Association budget and by local districts fundraising to pay for their SP visit, additional costs must be covered by the officer. To assist in that cost, the lodges in their home district may hold fundraisers to show their love and support. At the recent DD Clinic held at Eustis Lodge, Russ shared that he has a goal of \$15,000. Please let your lodge officers know if you have any ideas for a fundraiser sponsored by our lodge. Russ is willing to come to any event if his travel schedule is open.
