GENERAL INFORMATION

<u>Eligibility</u>:

To be eligible to apply for a scholarship award from the Ocala Elks Lodge Scholarship Fund, you must:

- 1. Be a student in the graduating class of a high school or its related equivalent.
- 2. Seniors graduating at semester (December) must apply during the application year before they graduate.
- 3. Be a resident of the state of Florida.
- 4. Be a United States citizen.

Students Targeted:

The Ocala Elks Lodge Scholarship is open to students who have maintained an un-weighted GPA of 2.30 to 3.59. **Students with an un-weighted GPA above 3.59 cannot apply**. We are looking for students who have demonstrated leadership through participation in school activities, community service, and citizenship. Special consideration is given to those students who have shouldered extra responsibility such as working throughout their high school career to help provide support for siblings or family.

Competition:

Boys and girls will compete for identical awards.

Awards and Amounts:

Annually, the Ocala Elks Lodge will offer scholarships to deserving graduating senior applicants of \$1,000 per recipient. These scholarships are funded through generous donations by members and supporters of the Ocala Elks Lodge.

Scoring:

The following Merit Standards will prevail:

GENERAL INFORMATION (Continued)

The Scholarship:

The scholarship is presented with the understanding that the recipient will enroll in a 4-year undergraduate program of study at an accredited American college or university, a junior college, an accredited vocational or technical training program, or a first responders academy. Upon receipt of verification of enrollment and proof of class attendance from the proper school officials, the Ocala Elks Lodge will issue a check in the amount of the award which will be forwarded to the college, university, or community college to establish a credit in the name of the recipient.

Restrictions on Use of Scholarship:

There is no restriction for the use of the scholarship. It may be utilized for tuition, books, lab fees, tutoring, room & board, transportation, food, uniforms, etc.

Unacceptable Conduct:

All scholarship recipients are expected to be good citizens of their community. These principles of law and order and morality are supported by the Order of the Elks. Therefore, unexpended credit is subject to withdrawal by the Ocala Elks Lodge if the conduct of the student is contrary to these principles.

Applications Become Property of the Ocala Elks Lodge:

After completing this application, please save a copy for your records. All applications become the property of the Ocala Elks Lodge.

Award Distribution:

Scholarship funds must be disbursed within two years of award decision.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Applications <u>must</u> be submitted on the enclosed three-page scholarship application form pages 5-7. The application <u>must</u> be dated and signed by the student and a parent/guardian on page 5.

2. Parental financial information <u>must</u> be submitted on the current official two-page form included in this packet pages 8 & 9. The information form <u>must</u> be dated, signed, and notarized on page 9. Generally, parental financial information is provided on the parent with whom the applicant resides if more than 50% of the time.

3. All applicants are required to submit a copy of their parent's/guardian's 2023 IRS Form 1040/1040A.

4. Unsigned or incomplete applications will not be considered.

5. Applications and all supporting documents <u>must</u> be in English.

6. It is preferable that exhibits such as awards and media items be photocopies.

7. When completing the application form, carefully plan a response to each item before typing the final draft. Pay close attention to the requirements for each section and secure all required dates.

8. If more room is needed to complete your responses for pages 6 or 7, you may continue them on one (1) separate sheet referring in the application that they are continued. On the added sheet, type the heading for the question(s) whose answer(s) is/are being continued on it. Include this sheet as the sixth page of your application.

9. All applicants are required to submit an essay answering the questions why you deserve a scholarship and what your future aspirations are. The essay must discuss the area of study where the scholarship will be applied, why that area was selected, and how your education will benefit society. The essay should be between 250 to 300 words in 12 pt. type and Times New Roman font. The essay <u>must</u> be dated and signed.

10. ACT or SAT scores <u>must</u> be submitted with your application. Photocopies are acceptable.

11. Your application package <u>must</u> contain at least one (1) but no more than two (2) letters of endorsement (originals or photocopies) from a high school teacher. The letter(s) may cover the applicant's work habits, leadership, personality, and integrity. Each letter should be typed, dated, signed, and be no longer than one side of an 8-1/2 by 11- inch page.

12. Your application package <u>must</u> contain at least one (1) but no more than two (2) letters of endorsement (originals or photocopies) from a responsible community (non-school) member. These persons should not be related to the applicant. They should be capable of reporting the applicant's participation in the community in terms of work, service, leadership skills, and outstanding recognition. Each letter should be typed, dated, signed, and be no longer than one side of an 8-1/2 by 11- inch page.

13. Your application package may contain up to three (3) pages of copies or exhibits depicting achievement in scholarship, leadership, athletics, dramatics, community service, or other activities.

14. Unopened official high school/home school transcripts <u>must</u> be submitted with your application. They <u>must</u> bear an original signature of the proper school authority or in the case of home-schooled applicants, the signature

of the proper school official of the district in which the student was home-schooled. Transcripts <u>must</u> cover student grades from the beginning of the 9th grade through the first semester of their senior year if available.

15. All applicants <u>must</u> provide the Counselor Report forms (pages 10 & 11) to their High School Counselor or Appropriate School Official and then obtain that report back from the Counselor in a sealed envelope. This envelope <u>must</u> be submitted with your application.

16. The application package, including all attachments and inclusions, <u>must</u> be submitted in a Mead folder with inside pockets and clasps. For the purposes of establishing citizenship, a copy of the applicant's driver's license, state issued identification, or U.S. passport should accompany the application.

17. All items except items received in a sealed envelope should be three hole punched and placed in the clasps of the folder and should be arranged in the following order:
